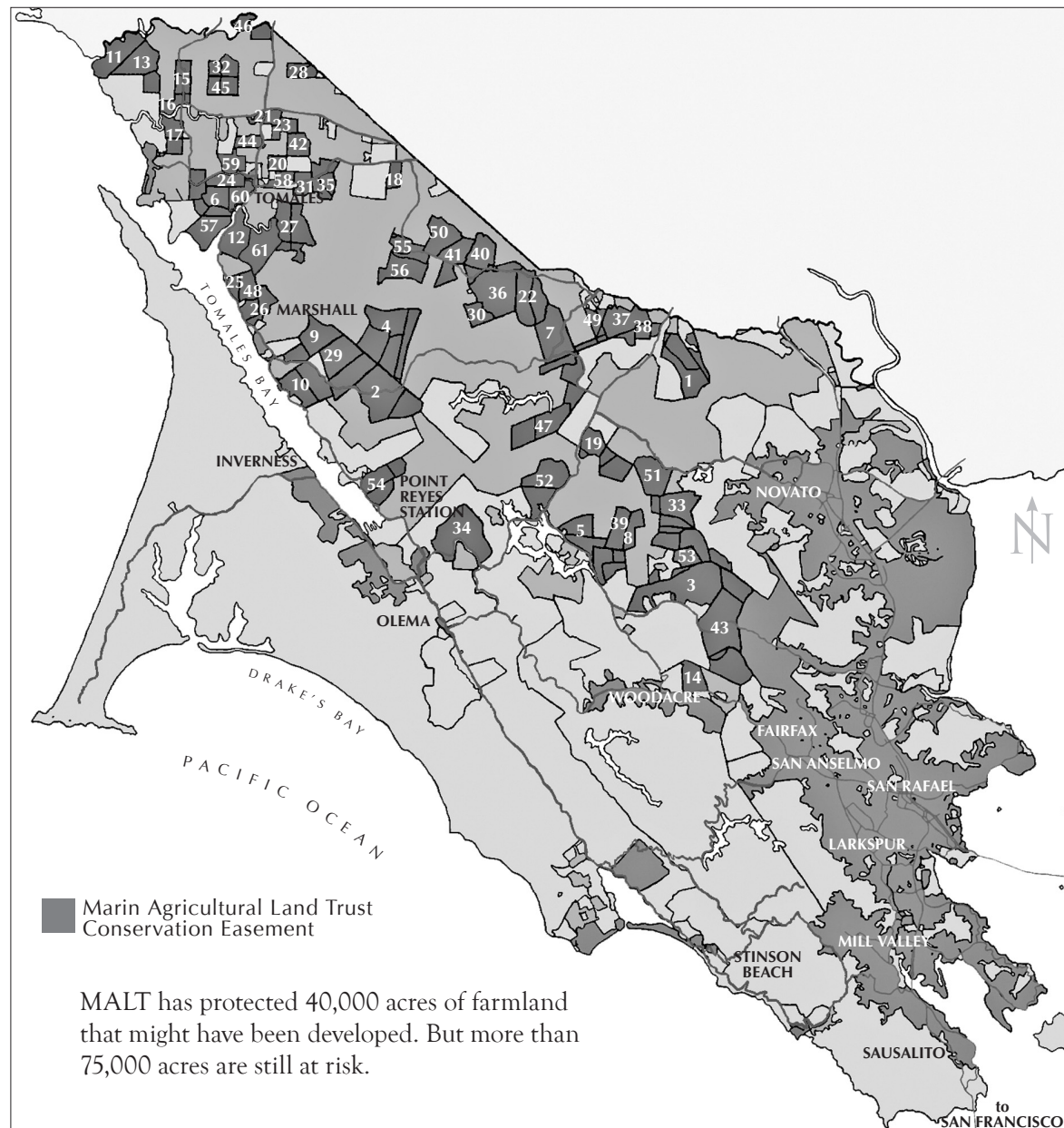

Land Preservation Report Spring 2008

Marin County's agricultural land is one of its greatest assets, but the proximity of the sprawling metropolitan Bay Area threatens our 150-year-old tradition of family farming with land uses such as luxury homes and rural estates.

Even though land prices have far outpaced values based on farm incomes, most farm families want to continue in agriculture. Marin Agricultural Land Trust (MALT) is able to offer ranchers a conservation alternative to the sale or development of their land.

Since its founding in 1980, MALT has protected 40,000 acres of farmland that might have been developed. But more than 75,000 acres are still at risk.

This report describes the 61 ranches and family farms that MALT's agricultural conservation easement program has helped preserve so far.
